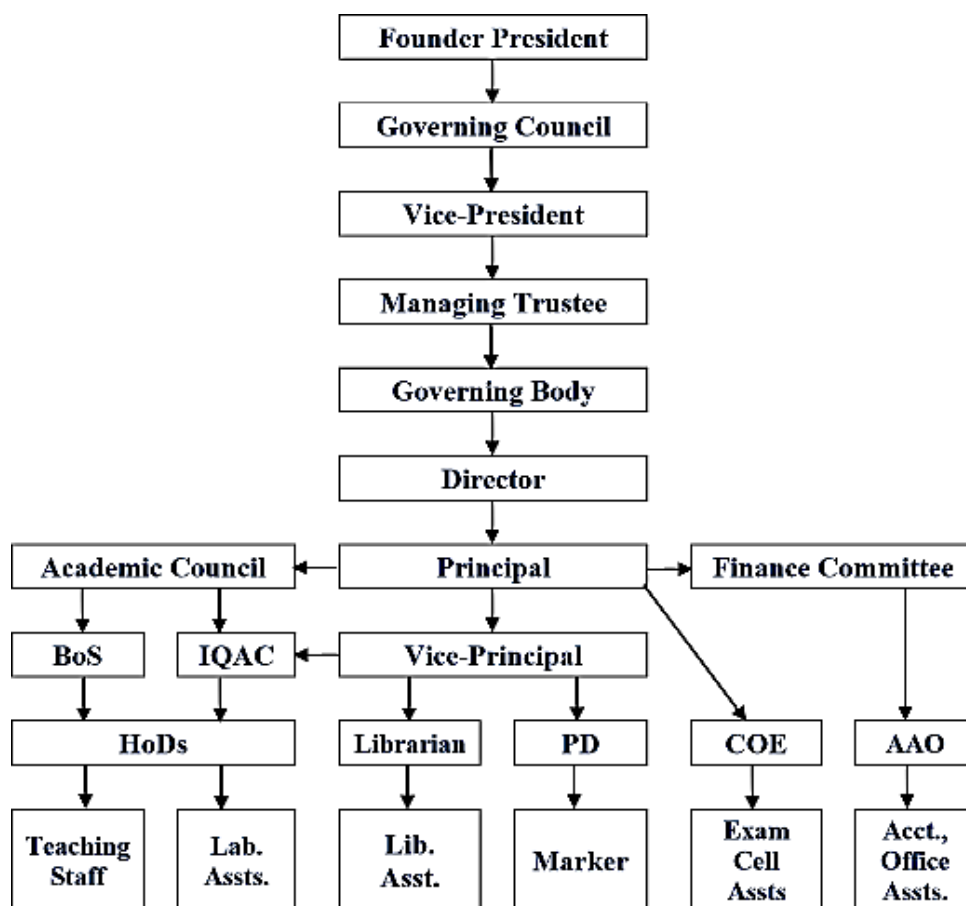

(E) A Bachelor's degree in any discipline with mathematics as one of the subjects at the higher secondary level [i.e. in +2 level of the 10+2pattern]

#### **Eligibility for the Award of Degree:**

A candidates shall be eligible for the award of the degree only if he/she has undergone the prescribed course of study in the college for a period of not less than three academic years and passed the examinations of all the four semesters prescribed earning 90 credits and fulfilled such conditions as have been prescribed therefore.

#### **1. Duration:**

The course duration shall be two years consisting of four Semesters

#### **2. Examinations:**

The duration of Semester Examination for theory and practical subjects shall be 3 hours. The Maximum mark for each theory is 100 with 25 for continuous Internal Assessment [CIA] and 75 Semester Examinations. The Maximum marks for each practical is 100 with 25 for Internal Assessment and 75 for Semester Examination.

Internal Assessment : 50 Marks For the conduct of Semester Examination in practical subjects, the college will appoint two external examiners. The College will set the questions and distribute to the Colleges. The examiners will conduct the examinations and award the marks on the same day and forward to the University. The Principal / Head of the Department will coordinate to provide the laboratory and other facilities for conducting the examination. Project work shall be carried out individually in an R&D section of any industry or University or in the Institute in which the candidate is studying. The Project work / Dissertation report shall be submitted through the guides / Supervisors to the Head of the Department and then to the University not later the 31st May / 31st December. If he/she fail to submit the Project Work / Dissertation within the stipulated date for particular semester, he/she may be permitted with the approval of the HOD to submit the Project work / Dissertation report during the succeeding semesters, within the maximum period of Five years from the date of admission to the First Semester. Project Work/ Dissertation evaluation and Viva- Voce shall be conducted by two external examiners.



### **3. Requirements for Proceeding to Subsequent Semester:**

- i) Candidates shall register their name for the first semester Examination after the admission in the P.G. Courses.
- ii) Candidates shall be permitted to proceed from the first semester up to the final semester irrespective of their failure in any of the semester examinations subject to the condition that the candidates should register for all the arrear subject of earlier semesters along the current (subsequent) semester subjects.
- iii) Candidates shall be eligible to go to subsequent semester, only if they earn sufficient attendance as prescribed there for by the academic council from time to time. provided in case of a candidate earning less than 65 % of attendance in any one of the semester due to any extraordinary circumstances such as medical grounds, such candidates who shall produce Medical Certificate issued by the Authorized Medical Attendant (AMA), duly certified by principal of the college, shall be permitted to proceed to the next semester and to complete the course of study. Such candidates shall have to repeat the missed semester by rejoining after completion of final semester of the course, after paying the fee for the break of study as prescribed by the college from time to time.

### **4. Passing Minimum:**

A Candidate shall be declared to have passed the whole Examination, if he/she passes in all the papers and practical wherever prescribed / as per the scheme of examinations by earnings by earning 90 credits.

#### **In fixing the passing minimum marks, the following will be observed:**

- a) There shall be no passing Minimum for Internal.
- b) For External Examination, Passing Minimum shall be of 50 % (Fifty percentages) of the maximum marks prescribed for the paper for each paper/Practical/Project and Viva-Voce.
- c) In the aggregate (External + Internal), the passing minimum shall be of 50 % for the paper for each paper/Practical/Project and Viva-Voce.
- d) Grading shall be based on Overall Marks Obtained [Internal + External].

### **5. Classification of Successful Candidates:**

Candidates who secured not less than 60% of aggregate marks [Internal + External] in the whole examination shall be declared to have passed the examination in the first Class. All other successful candidates shall be declared to have passed in Second Class. Candidates who obtain 75% of the marks in the aggregate [Internal + External] shall be deemed to have passed the examination in First Class with Distinction, provided they pass

all the examinations [Theory papers, practical, and project and Viva- voce] prescribed for the course in the first appearance.

#### **6. Requirements to take the Semester Examinations:**

- a) A Candidate will be permitted to take the Examination for any semester, If
  - i) He / she secure not less than 75 % of attendance out of the 90 instructional days during the semester. [In the case married women students the minimum attendance requirements shall be 55% of the total instruction days]
  - ii) He/ she earns a progress certificate from the Head of the Institution of having satisfactorily completed the course of Study prescribed in the subjects as required by theregulations, and
  - iii) His / her conduct has been satisfactory.

Provided that it shall be open the academic council or any authority delegated with such powers by the academic council to grant exemption to a candidate who has failed to earn 75% of the attendance prescribed for any valid reasons(s) subject to the usual conditions.

- a) A candidate who secured attendance less than 75% but 65% and above shall be permitted to take the examination on the recommendation of the Head of the Institution to condone the lack of attendance as well as on the payment of the prescribed fees to the college.
- b) A candidate who has secured attendance less than 65 % but 55% and above in Any semester, has to compensate the shortage of attendance in the subsequent Semester besides, earning the required percentage of attendance in that semester and Take the examination of both the semester papers together at the end of the latter Semester.
- c) A Candidate who secured less that 55% of attendance in any semester will not be permitted to take the regular examinations. He/ She to re-do the course after the completion of the final Semesters by rejoining the semester in which the attendance is less than55%.
- d) A Candidate who secured less than 65% of attendance in, the final semester has to compensate his / her attendance shortage in a manner to be decided by the Head of the department concerned after rejoining the course.

#### **7. Grading System:**

In addition to the above marking system, grading system is also adopted as detailed below:

[a] The Marks (Sum of IA and UE marks] in each course is assigned with a letter grade on a seven points scale using the following letter grade points and ranges of marks.
