Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq, Principal, presented the Progress report, Minutes of 9th meeting of Academic Council, 22nd meeting of Finance Committee, Receipts and Payments of Revenue account and Examination account.

Mr. C. Sureshbabu, Controller of Examinations, presented the report on examinations. Dr. G. Ezhilan and Dr. C. Dhandapani expressed satisfaction about the activities of the exam cell.

Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq presented the report on the College activities from 1.7.2018 to 30.11.2019. Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq informed that the +2 students of nearby schools are invited to the college for participation in a prayer conducted for their successful completion of their exams. Dr. C. Dhandapani suggested getting permission from the Chief Educational Officer for this programme. The Principal informed that the staff are taking classes for nearby school students. Dr. G. Ezhilan enquired about conducting any program for the benefit of slow learners. Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq replied that a booklet has been prepared by the Departments of Tamil, English and Mathematics for the benefit of students. Dr. C. Dhandapani enquired about scholarships for students of economically weaker sections. Principal informed that the class toppers are given scholarships on the occasion of the Founder President's birthday. Dr. C. Dhandapani asked whether there is any separate cell for dealing with scholarship. The Principal replied that the Office is handling the scholarship.

Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq presented the Results of the Autonomous examinations and the Future plans of the institution. Dr. G. Ezhilan suggested conducting 15 day bridge course in English for I year UG students. The Principal assured that this will be conducted. He also informed that the works on separate library block and auditorium is about to complete and will be inaugurated very soon. Then the Principal presented the Future plans of the institution.

Sakthi Thiru G. Anbalagan thanked the Members for their useful and constructive suggestions, advice and motivations, and assured them that their suggestions will be implemented. Then he moved the resolutions.
