Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq, Chairman of the Academic Council, welcomed all the members to the 10<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Academic council. He introduced the new Members of the Academic Council to the other members.

The Chairman invited members to move the resolutions as per the Agenda.

1. Mrs. C. Drakshayini moved the resolution for the syllabus for Part II English [Foundation] (Communicative English and Professional English) for all UG courses for Semesters I to II under CBCS Pattern, as given in the **Annexure-1**, as per the recommendation of the Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education (TANSCHÉ) and Thiruvalluvar University, to be adopted for implementation from the academic year 2020-2021 and thereafter in the college.

Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq informed the members that the syllabus and study materials for the II Semester have not yet been published by the TANSCHÉ, and once the syllabus is published, it will be followed by the college. Dr. B. Kathiresan informed that he will enquire with the authorities and inform.

The resolution was passed unanimously.

2. Dr. G. Anandharaj moved the resolution for the revised syllabus for M.C.A. for Semesters I to IV under CBCS Pattern, as given in the **Annexure-2**, to take effect from the academic year 2020-2021 and thereafter in the college.

Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq informed that as the AICTE has modified the M.C.A. course as a 2 year course from this academic year, the college has completely revised the syllabus. Dr. Babu Janarthanan, Dr. Dinakaran and Dr. Kathiresan enquired about the Non-major elective (NME) papers offered by the Computer Science department to other department students and also the NME papers offered by other departments to Computer Science students. They expressed satisfaction with the NME papers offered by the departments. They suggested that the NME papers may be offered as open for all courses, so that any student can opt for any course of his/her choice.

The resolution was passed unanimously.

3. Mr. C. Sureshbabu moved the resolution for the approval of the results for the even semester End Semester Examination (ESE) of the academic year 2019-2020 (Apr/May, 2020).

Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq informed that in view of the CoVID-19 pandemic and as per the recommendations of the UGC and Thiruvalluvar University, the Examination Cell has conducted the End Semester Examinations for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Courses (Apr/May, 2020 and Oct/Nov, 2020) through online mode. He informed that online examinations were conducted by asking the students to join GoogleMeet and write the examinations in front of the camera with monitoring by the class tutor. The University

nominees Dr. Babu Janarthanan, Dr. Dinakaran and Dr. Kathiresan appreciated that the students wrote the examinations in front of the camera.

Dr. Dinakaran suggested including Research and Publication Ethics as a mandatory subject for M.Phil. students. Dr. A. Mohamed Sadiq informed that it will be carried out.

The resolution was passed unanimously.
