

#### **FREE MEDICAL AID**

Adhiparasakthi Institute of Science Agriculture and Technology (APISAT) founded by the Trust is unique that is totally committed to quality innovation dynamism and social relevance. Study, Spirituality and Service are its MOTTO. Inculcation of character and virtues, besides academic training are its hallmark. Duty, Dignity and Discipline are its watchwords. It is keen that students should shine as model citizens and men of eminence and excellence in our society.

Adhiparasakthi College of Arts & Science is the first self-financing college started in this part of the state in the year 1988. It was affiliated to Madras University till the academic year 2000-2001 and from the year 2001-2002 onwards, it is affiliated to Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore. To begin with three undergraduate courses viz., B.Sc., Biochemistry, Microbiology and Computer Science were

offered. In the year 1993-94, the college was upgraded as postgraduate college and started offering M.C.A., programme. From 1994-95, M.Sc., Biochemistry and M.Sc., Applied Microbiology were added. In the year 1999-2000. B.C.A. was introduced from 2001-2002, M.Sc., Information Technology and M.Sc., Computer Science and Technology were offered in the college. B.Com. and B.B.A. Courses were introduced from 2004-2005. M.Phil (Full time and Part time) in Computer Science, Biochemistry and Microbiology were introduced in 2004-2005. M.Com. was introduced from 2007-2008. M.Phil (Full time and Part time) in Commerce was introduced in 2009.

The College has been recognized as a center for Ph.D. Programmes in Biochemistry and Microbiology in the year 2008 and Ph.D Programme in Computer Science in the year 2014. B.Sc Mathematics course was introduced from 2012-2013. M.Sc Mathematics course was introduced from 2015-16. M.Phil Mathematics course was introduced from 2018-2019. Ph.D Programme in Commerce was introduced from 2019-2020. The College has received permanent affiliation from the Thiruvalluvar University during 2008-2009. The college is conferred with Autonomous status from the year 2011-2012. The college has been Re-accredited by NAAC with B Grade (CGPA-2.83) in 2014, and with B++ Grade in 2022.

The college has two imposing buildings for UG and PG courses with separate well equipped laboratories and spacious class rooms. The students live in a pollution free and calm atmosphere during the course of study. On the whole, the college has magnificent view with serene atmosphere conductive for healthy academic life.

- 28. Hostel vessels such as tumblers, water jugs, etc. found in the rooms will attract fine and punishment.
- 29. "Ragging" in any form inside or outside the hostel is an offence and will be dealt with as per law. These rules and regulations are imposed in the larger interest of the students and to protect the fair-name of the college. Any hostel student violating the rules and regulations will be fined by the warden or principal on the basis of the nature of the offence. In extreme cases the offender will be sent out of the hostel on condition that he should stay outside only with parents or guardian. Students who do not comply with above regulations will be expelled from the college.
- 30. The students are permitted to watch essential T.V. programmes as decided by the Deputy Warden.
- 31. The Students should be confined to their rooms. Migrating to the other rooms during study hours is strictly prohibited.
- 32. No student is permitted to stay in their rooms during college hours, unless they are sick or ill.
- 33. Students should use water sparingly and co-operate to conserve the water.
- 34. Any questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the Warden or principal and his interpretation of the rules shall be final.

- 16. Any complaint against any employee of the hostel for any cause may be made in writing to Deputy-Warden for action. No member shall take law in his own hands, however grave or provocative the conduct of the employee may be.
- 17. Smoking, gambling, shouting, drinking and drugging inside the hostel campus is strictly prohibited.
- 18. Possession of cigarettes, alcoholic beverages, intoxicating drugs, etc. is strictly prohibited.
- 19. Any breach of discipline in the hostel shall be dealt with either by fine, suspension or expulsion from the hostel. Expulsion from the hostel, temporary or permanent shall entail similar expulsion from the college.
- 20. Members of the hostel should not go outside the hostel campus for bathing, face washing, etc.
- 21. Members of the hostel should not organise or convene meeting of any sort without the written permission of the Deputy Warden and Warden.
- 22. Students who were expelled for non-payment of mess dues will be permitted to join the hostel only after clearing the dues.
- 23. A student who is removed or suspended from the college shall automatically cease to be the member of the hostel.
- 24. The mess dues of scholarship holders shall be adjusted from their scholarship amount available. Any extra dues must be cleared by the student.
- 25. No lady except a student's mother is permitted to visit the hostel unless specially permitted by the Deputy Warden.
- 26. Every student seeking admission in the hostel should give an undertaking in the prescribed form along with parents endorsement.
- 27. Students are advised to refrain causing any damage to hostel properties. Any such incident brought to notice will be viewed seriously.

- 5. No student shall leave the hostel after 7.00 p.m. Students staying out beyond 7.00 p.m without permission will be severely dealt with.
- 6. However, owing to unforeseen reasons a student has to go out without permission, he/she shall record his/her name and the nature of his business in the notebook kept for the purpose.
- 7. The inmates should not tamper the electrical installations in their rooms. The use of extra lights, electric heater or electric iron or fan or radio is strictly forbidden.
- Members shall not move the furniture from one place to another or exchange among themselves. They are prohibited from defacing or damaging the furniture in any way. The cost of any damage so caused shall be recovered from them.
- 9. The mess dues must be paid in the college office before the prescribed date.
- 10. Members are advised not to leave cash or valuables in their rooms. The hostel authorities will not be responsible for articles or cash lost by members. They are also advised to open a savings account in the bank situated in the college.
- 11. Boarders shall on no account be served meals or Tiffin in their rooms except when they are ill.
- 12. No member shall enter the kitchen.
- 13. No guest can be entertained without the permission from the Deputy Warden.
- 14. Severe action shall be taken on the boarders who permit non members to stay in their rooms.
- 15. Members should maintain silence in their rooms.

- 3. Borrowing books from the Library will be by the card system. The card is not transferable and books can not be borrowed on behalf of others. If a card is lost or mutilated or damaged, it will be replaced at a cost of Rs. 101-. Students will have to surrender the cards at the end of each academic year.
- 4. Each and every student is eligible to get a maximum number of two cards.
- 5. Students are entitled to keep a book for two weeks from the Date of issue. If the books are not returned on or before the due date, a fine of Rs.2/- per day for a book (including holidays) will be collected up to 5 days. Further Rs. 51- will be collected thereafter for 10 days. Still if the students fail to return the book, the students will not be permitted to use the library and they will not be allowed to attend the college till the fine is paid and the books are returned. Books due on a holiday may be returned without fine on the next working day. Absence from the college will not ordinarily be accepted as an excuse for delay in the return of books.
- The library books are meant for reference purpose only. Students should not withhold the books till the University Examinations.
- 7. Reference books cannot be taken out of the library. No one is allowed to sub lend the books taken by him / her to others.
- 8. After two weeks from the date of issue, a book may be reissued if there is no reservation for it.
- Students may read magazines, periodicals and newspapers in leisure period but are not allowed to take them home.
- 10. Any kind of marking, underlining, clipping or annotating of books is absolutely forbidden. Readers shall be responsible for damage done to the books belonging to the library and shall be required to replace such books or pay the value thereof.
- 11. Silence shall be observed at all times in the library.
- 12. All payments including fine shall be paid in the college office and the receipt to be shown to the librarian.
- 13. The librarian may recall any book at anytime even when normal period of loan has not expired.

4. The concessions granted are liable to be withdrawn in all cases of misconduct such as resorting to or participating in strikes etc.

#### **COLLEGE RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1. "Ragging" is strictly prohibited by an act promulgated by the government of TamilNadu with penalty or imprisonment or both Ragging of any kind is prohibited either in the college campus or in the hostel or outside. The students who are guilty of this offence will be expelled from the college and also handed over to the police for further action as per the government orders.
- 2. Exchange of greetings with members of the staff in the College and Hostel is highly recommended.
- 3. Every day the first period starts with "Moolamandiram" and last period ends with "Vaazhthu".
- 4. Students are advised to use courteous and polite language and behave with decorum when talking to the faculty members and the staff of the college and hostel.
- 5. Students shall avoid using insulting, inciting and threatening language when talking with fellow students and should totally avoid violence.
- 6. Students shall not talk or act in any manner outside the institution in a way that would bring disrepute to the institution.
- 7. Students shall come clean, tidy and smartly dressed. Girl students should wear saree or churithar with dhuppatta only.
- On every Friday the staff and students should come in RED DRESS.
- Students should not leave the campus without prior permission during working hours.
- Students should not leave the class or attend it late under the pretext of paying fees or taking books from library. Time fixed for such purposes during working hours must be strictly adhered to.
- 11. Students shall be regular and punctual in attending classes and all activities connected with the college.

They are tenable for the period of the entire course on condition that their character, conduct and academic records continue to be satisfactory

- 1. ONLY THOSE STUDENTS WHO PUT IN NOT LESS THAN 90% ATTENDANCE ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE SCHOLARSHIPAS PERTHE GOVERNMENT ORDER.
- 2. The following categories of students irrespective of their caste are eligible for scholarship and fee concession.
  - (i) Handicapped students
  - (ii) Sons / daughters and dependents of freedom fighters.
  - (iii) Sons / daughters and dependents of service personnel.
  - (iv) Sons / daughters and dependents of ex-servicemen.
  - (v) Sons / daughters of Sri Lanka repatriates.
  - (vi) Sons / daughters of Burma repatriates.
  - (vi) Sons / daughters of teachers, who died while in service.
- 3. The following certificates should be produced in the prescribed form available in the college office at the time of applying for Fee Concessions and Scholarships.
  - (a) A declaration certificate by the parent or guardian.
  - (b) A certificate of income signed by an Officer of the Revenue Department, not lower in rank than a Deputy Tahsildar.
  - (c) Converts to Christianity are eligible for the concession and have to produce, in addition, a certificate of conversion in the prescribed form obtained from an officer who is competent to issue the income certificate.

- circumstances extending beyond three days, the Principal may require Medical or other certificates.
- 2. Application for leave from students residing in the college hostel should be recommended by the Deputy Warden.
- 3. Those who are late by more than 5 minutes will not be admitted into the class except on valid reasons.
- 4. A student requiring leave for a period or a portion of a period must get permission from the Lecturer, in person, before the beginning of class.
- 5. A student absenting himself / herself without leave during one period of the day will be considered as absent for half-a-day. Absent for a period in the F.N. session and a period & in the A.N. session shall be marked absent for the whole day.
- 6. A student absenting himself/herself for three days and more shall be fined at the discretion of the Principal and the fact shall be informed to his / her parents.
- 7. A student who continuously absents himself / herself for fifteen days without valid reasons will have his/her name struck off the rolls.
- 8. Absconder from classes and habitual absentees shall be dealt severely. The punishment may involve suspension or removal from the college.
- 9. The students studying in U.G. Degree courses and P.G. Degree courses should put in a minimum of 75% and 80% of attendance respectively for appearing in semester examinations.
- 10. The above rule is applicable to the practical classes also.

#### **FEE CONCESSIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS**

A number of scholarships are awarded annually to deserving students based on the results of the last examination they appeared.

- 12. Gathering in groups at roads, entrance, pathways, gardens, and other places is strictly prohibited.
- 13. On entering the class, they shall observe strict silence, irrespective of the presence or absence of the teacher.
- 14. Students should assemble in the respective lecture halls, five minutes before the beginning of the period. They shall stand as the teacher enters the class and keep standing till they are asked to be seated.
- 15. While attending college functions, the students will conduct themselves in such a way as to bring credit to themselves and to the institution.
- 16. No student is permitted to leave the classroom during the class hours.
- 17. Students shall promptly stand to solemn attention when prayer or National Anthem is being played at a function.
- 18. Smoking, drinking and other activities like drugging etc., in the college premises as well as outside are strictly prohibited. Erring students will be dealt severely, including dismissal from the college.
- 19. Students are forbidden from entering the college office and the staff rooms during unspecified hours.
- 20. Students are prohibited from defacing or damaging the building or furniture. The cost of any damage so caused will be recovered from the students collectively if the responsibility for it can not be fixed on any individual or group of individuals.
- 21. Disobedience, malpractice or prompting in examinations and other moral delinquencies shall be severely dealt with.
- 22. Representation of complaints and grievances may be made individually to the Principal through the heads of the departments.
- 23. Students are expected to read the notice board. Ignorance of any notice will not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with it.

- 24. Any lost property found must be handed over to the office from whom the owner can claim it promptly after proving his/her ownership.
- 25. Any student found willfully preventing other students from attending classes and inciting strikes will be expelled from the college.
- 26. Students taking part in communal or political activities will be severely dealt with.
- 27. No meeting of any kind shall be held in the college without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 28. No student of the College shall be a member of any association unconnected with the college.
- No notice of any kind shall be circulated among students or displayed on black boards or on notice boards without the written permission of the Principal.
- No information or report should be sent to press or broadcasting agencies without the permission and approval of the Principal.
- 31. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 32. The Principal's decision shall be final in matter of punishment of the students for violation of any of the rules of the college.
- 33. Students who leave in the middle of the course shall pay the fees for the remaining period and get clearance certificate.

- 35. The names of students, who have not paid the tuition fees even one month after the pay with fine date, will be removed from the rolls of the college. They will be readmitted only after the payment of fees dues and readmission fee of Rs. 501/-
