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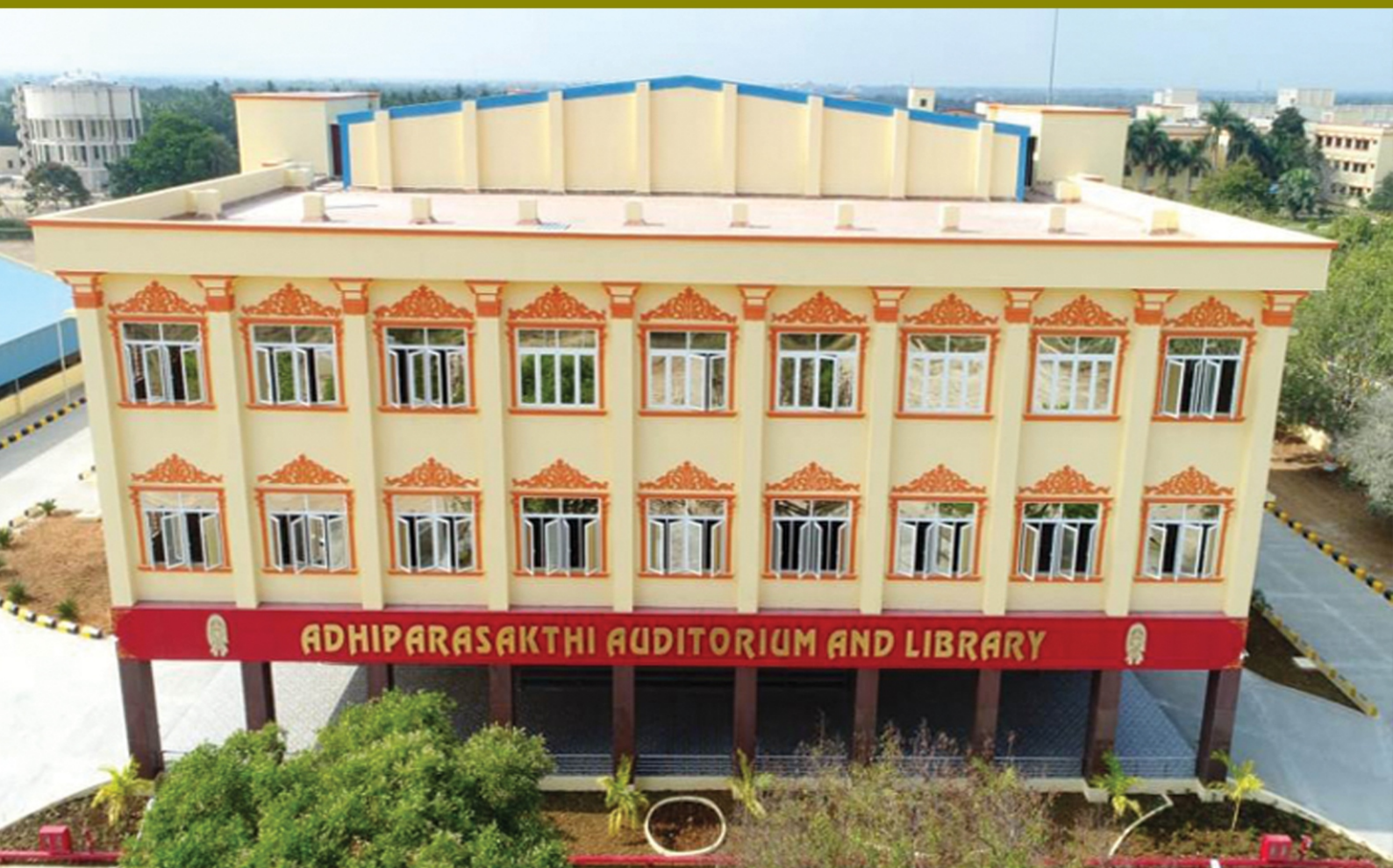

Adhiparasakthi College of Science was the first self-financing college established in 1988. It was affiliated with Madras University till the academic year 2000 – 2001 and from the year 2001 – 2002 onwards it has been affiliated with Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore. Initially three undergraduate courses namely B.Sc., Biochemistry, Microbiology and Computer Science were offered. In the year 1993-94, the college was upgraded to Postgraduate College and started offering the M.C.A., programme from 1994-95, followed by M.Sc., Biochemistry and M.Sc., Applied Microbiology. In the academic year 1999-2000, The B.C.A program was introduced. From 2001-2002 M.Sc., Information Technology and M.Sc., Computer Science and Technology were offered in the college. B.Com and B.B.A courses were introduced in 2004-2005. M.Phil (Full time and part time) programs in Computer Science, Biochemistry and Microbiology were introduced in 2004-2005. M.Com was introduced in 2007- 2008. The college has been recognized as a centre for Ph.D. Programmes in Biochemistry and Microbiology in the year 2008. B.Sc., Mathematics course was introduced in 2012-2013. The college has been accredited by NAAC with B++ grade from 2007 and reaccredited with B Grade with a CGPA score of 2.83 in 2014. The college has received permanent affiliation from Thiruvalluvar University during 2008-2009. The College is conferred with Autonomous status from the year 2011-2012. The College has a total building area of 10,092.97 square meters. It includes two separate buildings for UG and PG courses with well-equipped laboratories and spacious class rooms. There is a hygienic canteen which provides beverages, breakfast and lunch. Separate Hostels are available for boys and girls. The hostels provide hygienic vegetarian food. Students benefit from a pollution-free, calm and serene atmosphere.
