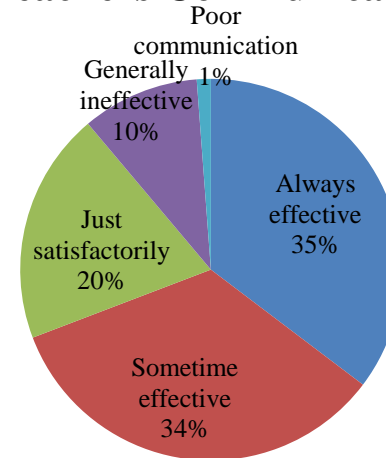

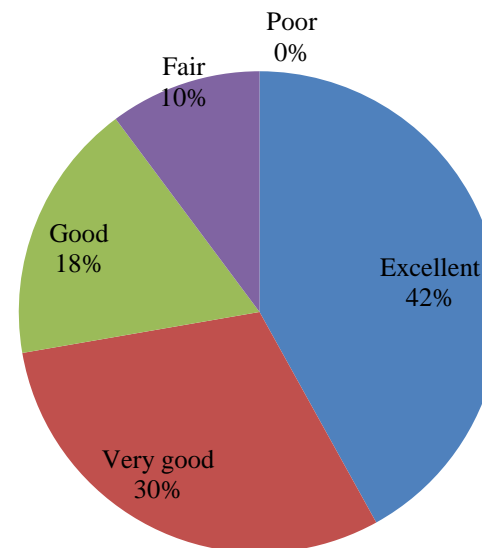

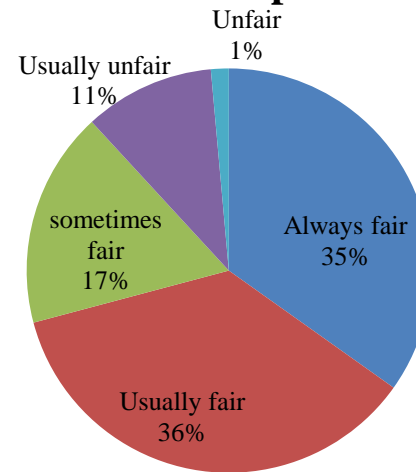

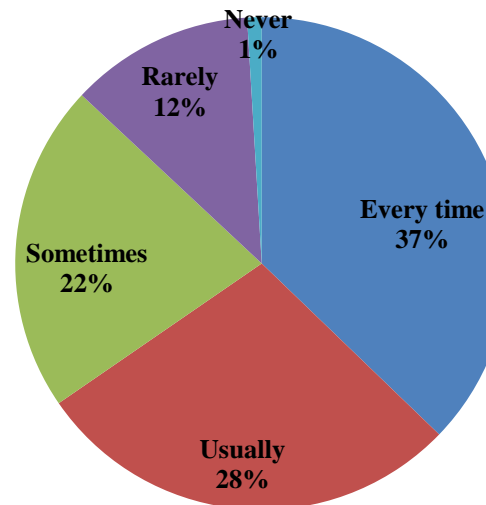
Internal evaluation process by teacher

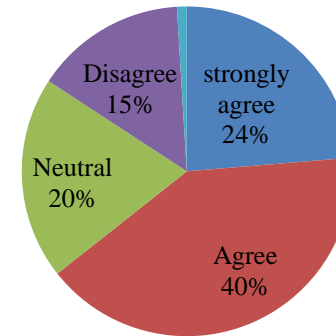

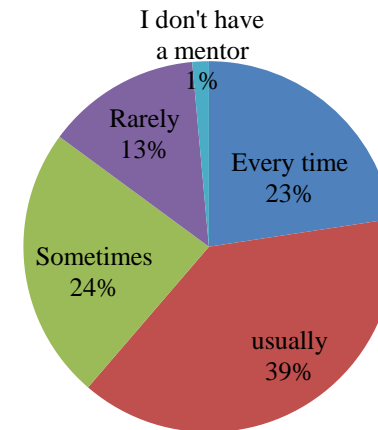

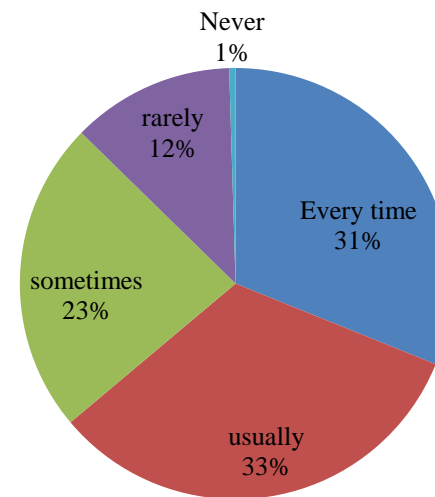

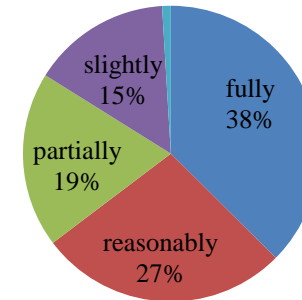

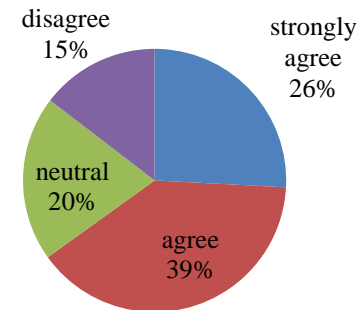
Teaching Learning Process

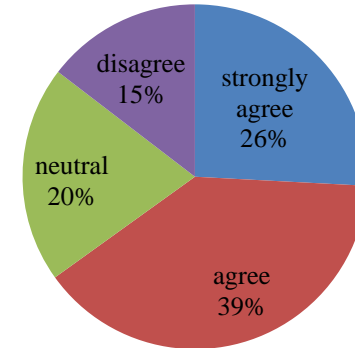

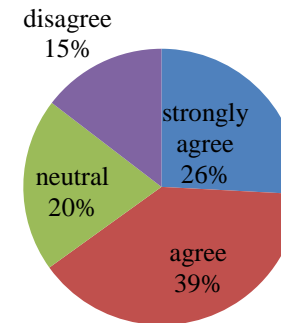

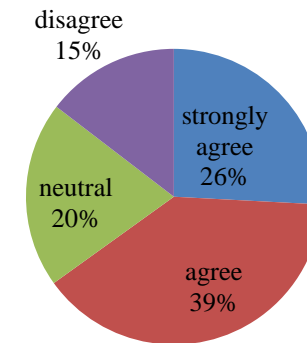
Skill Orientation
